## Rules:

- r. 1 - q is always followed by u (queen)
- r. 9 - 1-1-1 rule: One-syllable words with one vowel and ending with one consonant need another final consonant before adding a suffix that begins with a vowel (hop + ed = hop ped)
- r. 19 - i and o may say /ī/ and /ō/ when followed by two consonants (find, old)
- r. 25 - ck may only be used after a single vowel that says /ă/, /ĕ/, /ĭ/, /ō/, or /ŭ/ (back, neck, lick, rock, duck)

## Silent Final E Jobs:

- Job 1 - The silent final e lets the vowel say its name.
